



Golf After School PE Program - Rules & Etiquette Details

Check In and Check Out Students will check in and out with the iPad on the front desk of the GPG indoor studio. We will be tracking their hours using this attendance form on the iPad. [After School Attendance Sheet](#) to check in attendance and use this as a report to the school counselor.

Make up hours available for any missed weekly class [Virtual Practice Bay](#) can be reserved for 1 make up hour/ weekly (Monday-Friday) to make up missed classes. Coaches will be here on the weekends Saturdays from 7am to 3pm and Sundays from 10 am to 2 pm. Students will be able to make up additional hours during these times on the weekends. Students will need to still record the hours on the iPad attendance form. Students will also have online assignments where they can complete the assignments for additional hours, if approved.

Students will be posting their practice notes on what they have learned during the hours on our player platform [CoachNow](#). This is another way the coaches will be monitoring the students during their practices and communicate with each student. We will create the student profile with both student and parents email address. This also allows the parents to see the players profile and see the assignments and practice notes from the student.

Rules and Etiquette While on Northgate property students will be required to be respectful of their surrounding areas. Students will not be screaming, running, or destroying any property at Northgate Country Club. Students will not break any golf course rules or etiquette while playing during their rounds. We will provide the students with the rules of golf so they have an understanding of the rules. Students will be warned for any misconduct, if misconduct continues this will affect their grade and potentially a failure grade. Students are required to meet their 5 hours of practice each week, failure to meet the weekly hours will result in a lower grade and possible failure for the semester.

The Grading curriculum will consist of class Attendance 50% and the remaining 50% will consist of completion of the drills and practice plans viewed by the coaches. Students can choose each day if they want to complete a practice plan (1-hour credit) or play the “fast five”, 5-hole course (2-hour credit). Multiple practice hours can be achieved in a single day.

Dress Code and Equipment Students will be required to wear golf attire during their class hours, this is a collar shirt, shorts/slacks for men, collar shirts shirts, skirts/plants for women and **no denim** tops or bottoms. We ask that all students have their own golf equipment (golf clubs, golf bags, and golf balls). Golf Performance Group does have some clubs to rent out but are limited on golf clubs. This way if they play on the Fast Five, they will have everything they need. Students will also be using their phone/tablet to post to their coach now during classes.
